

Huge crater develops in south Mumbai

A huge crater, measuring about 12 feet and almost 14 feet deep, developed on the busy Raja Ram Mohan Roy Road at the congested Prarthana Samaj locality of south [Mumbai](#) Saturday afternoon.

According to fire brigade officials, the reason for the crater's development is not known. Though there have been no casualties, a water main pipeline can be seen.

While police and fire brigade teams have rushed to the site, traffic on the road has been stopped since 2 p.m.

Police had a tough time controlling the thousands of curious onlookers who rushed to the area to see the crater.
