

We have done our job, time to pray: Sehwag

Delhi Daredevils captain Virender Sehwag said the team had done their job after beating [Mumbai Indians](#) here Saturday in their Indian Premier League (IPL) match and now was the time to pray for a semi-final berth.

'We have done our job. We had to win this match and we did that. The rest is not in our hands. We can only pray that other results go our way and we reach the last four,' Sehwag told reporters.

'The middle order clicked at the right time. Dinesh Karthik played a fabulous innings and he was supported well by Manoj Tiwary and Farvez Maharooof,' Sehwag said.
