Eclipse plug-in developers will see several improvements in the plug-in development environment (PDE). Several new security related features such as digital signatures have been introduced to ensure that the Eclipse environment is safe.

The new features of Eclipse Ganymede Version 3.4 release will be highlighted in addition to a few case studies of some interesting use-cases for Eclipse.
