

Jai Bhanushali to pull out of 'Kayamath'

Popular television actor Jai Bhanushali, who plays Neev Shergil in Ekta Kapoor's 'Kayamath', is all set to make an exit from the serial because he feels there is nothing left in it for him.

'Yes, I will be leaving the show shortly. It was decided long ago and Ekta too said she had no problems,' Jai told IANS.

'I think it's the right time for me to leave the show because I feel there is nothing left in it for me,' he said.

Jai won't be seen in any movie or serial soon after leaving 'Kayamath' even though he has quite a few offers in hand.
