

Pooja Gandhi replaces Tanya Vakil in 'Thiruvannamalai'

Kannada actress Pooja Gandhi has replaced Tanya Vakil in Tamil film 'Thiruvannamalai' and says she has a special role in this action flick.

The film is being directed by Perarasu and Pooja, who featured in hits like 'Mungaru Male', 'Milana' and the recently released 'Taj Mahal', is paired with action star Arjun in it.

'I know it will be an action entertainer. But Perarasu's previous records show that he has a knack for making box office hits. I have a special role in this racy entertainer,' Pooja told IANS.

The actress is currently shooting for 'Thiruvannamalai' in Chennai.
