

Kannada actress Radhika on cloud nine after Filmfare award

Two big hits and now a Filmfare award, Kannada actress Radhika Pandit is certainly going places and she says she will always try to live up to the expectations of her fans by doing good films.

Radhika won best actress Filmfare Award for her performance in her debut Kannada movie 'Moggina Manasu', which is directed by Shashank. The film that got rave reviews for its fresh concept and good performances from artists won five Filmfare awards, including for best director.

'The response was terrific in all the places where we went. We interacted with the audiences. We also addressed press meets in Shimoga, Davanagere and Hubli,' said Radhika.

Recently, some of her ardent fans got together to launch a website, which is dedicated to her. But Radkhika says she was unaware about it.

When I got the news from a reporter who also gave me the address of the website, I was a little curious as well as happy.
