

Disgusting to see TV channels do 'match-mixing': Katrina

Bollywood actress Katrina Kaif, who has been shooting non-stop for her upcoming film 'Rajneeti' with Ranbir Kapoor on the streets of Bhopal, says it is 'disgusting' to see television channels create controversies and indulge in 'match-mixing' to raise TRPs.

Earlier this week, a television channel went ballistic with an image showing her reaching out and hugging Ranbir Kapoor on a road. The clipping was aired with a question as to what her boyfriend actor Salman Khan would have to say on her public display of intimacy.
