

Gurgaon undertrial shot dead; two assailants killed

Gurgaon (Haryana) - Police gunned down two people hours after they shot dead an undertrial Friday morning in the district court complex in this Haryana town, near Delhi.

Hardutt, an undertrial in a murder case, was gunned down by three people at the judicial court complex Friday morning. The gangster, who received five bullets from close range, died on the spot. He had been brought to the court for an appearance in a case.

One of the assailants, Ravi Pandit, was killed inside a toilet of the court complex where he had hidden after the shootout, police said. A 9 mm pistol and bullets were recovered from his possession.

Another assailant, Anil alias Babloo, was shot by police at a barricade on the Sohana road after he refused to stop and also fired at the police party chasing him, said Inspector General of police Mohinder Lal.

He was taken to the civil hospital after the shootout but was declared brought dead by doctors. A 7.62 mm pistol and bullets were recovered from him.

The third attacker in the shootout - Jai Prakash - is absconding and the police are hot on his trail, he said.

According to police, Hardutt was gunned down due to gang rivalry in a pre-planned manner. Two other people were injured in the shootout.
