

## Dhoni's swimming pool attracts neighbours' ire, court notice

Indian skipper Mahendra Singh Dhoni has got embroiled in a legal battle over the construction of a swimming pool in his house in the Jharkhand's capital here.

The Jharkhand High Court Tuesday issued notices to Dhoni and the state government asking them to file replies to a Public Interest Litigation (PIL) filed against the construction of a swimming pool in the premises of a house that the cricketer is building at the Harmu housing colony.

Residents of the colony have filed the PIL on the grounds that the swimming pool would use up a lot of water and cause water scarcity in the colony.

A division bench comprising chief justice M.K. Vinayagam and justice D.K Sinha issued the notice asking both Dhoni and the state government to reply within four weeks.

Earlier, the colony residents had sent a petition to the
