

Gujjars to hold 'mahapadav' in Jaipur on March 10

The agitating Gujjars this time seem to be determined to go ahead with their mahapadav (mass sit-in) slated to be held here March 10.

Sankyut Gujjar Aarkshan Sangarsh Samiti (SGASS), an influential Gujjar organisation, told the state government that under no circumstances the mahapadav would be cancelled.

'Even if the government imposes national security act or arrest Samiti leaders or members, we are not going to cancel the padav,' Attar Singh Bhadana, a leader of the organisation, told reporters Saturday.

'We have already requested the government to give us a proper place for mahapadav. We do not want to hold it in Muhana on the outskirts of the city,' he said.

'If the government fails to provide us the space we would be forced to organise it in front of the state assembly,' Bhadana warned.
